- Guest seating
- Rugs, plinths, welcome signs or other feature pieces

- Pack down after the ceremony





## Our Styling Process

1. Book a 30 minute Discovery Session at our Styling Suite where you can explore our full collection in person. We'll chat about your ceremony & ceremony vision to make sure we can accommodate you.

## Wedding Components

### What is the ceremony?

The marriage ceremony's main purpose is to legally unite the couple through vows and ring exchange in front of your celebrant and witnesses. It often occurs separately from the reception, lasting 15 minutes to an hour, depending on traditions.

### What is the reception?

The reception, which often takes place at a different venue, follows the marriage ceremony. It can be hosted by an MC or a trusted friend or family member and can include a meal, speeches, dancing, and entertainment—a time for socialising and cherishing moments with loved ones and typically lasts for several hours.

## Planning a DIY Ceremony? Read This First

- Have you chosen a Marriage Celebrant? (We would love to be your celebrant too - ask us)
- Location, council approval and wet weather plans.
- Date and Time.
- Time of day for comfort of guests? Sun/Shade.
- Consider distance from parking to location
- Consider full cost of buying everything for your setup.
- Consider tools required for set up
- Consider if decorations are secure from wind.
- Consider time allocated for setup before guests arrive.
- Who will set up your guest seating? Cost/Hire Cost.
- Who will set up your arbour, florals, other decor?
- Will your helper miss moments of the ceremony?
- Who will pack everything away after the ceremony?
- Consider storage for decor while you're at your reception.
